- 23rd November—Flu Vaccinations

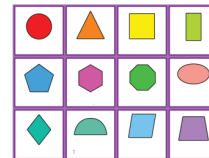
In Reading, we will be learning:

- Phase 5 alternative sounds e.g. ir, ie, ay
- Fluency—reading without the need to segment and blend
- Prosody—using a story telling voice when reading, using expression and a varying tone of voice
- Comprehension—understanding what we have read and answering questions using retrieval, inference and prediction skills.



In Maths, we will be learning about:

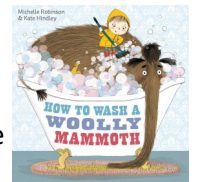
- Numbers and the number system, focusing on numbers to 20 and using number lines.
- Addition and Subtraction within 20 and number bonds to make 20.
- Exploring time, particularly days of the week, months of the year and sequencing in chronological order.
- Mathematical movement, focusing on whole turns, half turns, quarter turns and three-quarter turns and how we can describe these.



In Writing, we will be learning about:

How to write instructions:

Based on 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth'. This will include identifying the features of a good set of instructions (chronology, conjunctions, punctuation, imperative verbs) and using those to write our own instructions.



How to write a diary entry:

We will be writing about a familiar event, and ensuring we use the features of a diary entry e.g. writing in the past tense, writing in the first person, writing in chronological order and describing thoughts, feelings and emotions.

Our Curriculum Project is: Memory Box

Our main subject we will be focusing on is: History

We will be learning about:

- Changes within history and living memory including exploring toys from the past.
- Historical language to describe the passing of time.



In Art, we will be learning about:



Painting and mixed media, focusing on the title 'Colour Splash'. This will include mixing colours and using different objects to paint.

In Phonics, the sounds we learning are:



- Phase 5 (ir ie ue a-e i-e o-e u-e e-e ew ie aw)
- Alternative pronunciations for o i a e

In Music, we will be learning about:

- Finding the pulse within a piece of music
- Moving to the pulse



In P.E., we will be learning about:

- Gymnastics
- Sending and Receiving



In P.S.H.E / R.H.E , we will be learning about:

- Celebrating Difference
- Respecting similarities and differences
- Anti-bullying and being unique

In R.E, we will be learning about:

- Hinduism and where Hindus worship.
- Diwali, the importance of the Diva lamp and the story of Rama and Sita

In Computing, we will be learning about:

- How to use a computer safely
- How to log on to a laptop
- How to use a mouse and keyboard
