History workshop—date to be confirmed

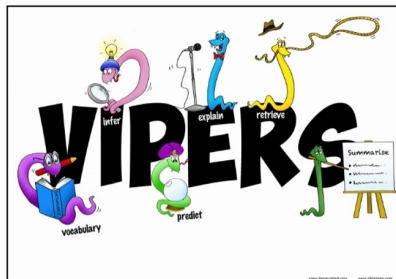
PE days: Wednesday and Friday

In Reading, we will be reading a wide range of texts relating including Non-Fiction, Fiction and Poetry. We will also be looking at texts relating to our curriculum Project

‘Tribal Tales’.

We will be continuing to use VIPERS skills to analyse the text and will be practising test style questions.



In Maths, we will be learning about:

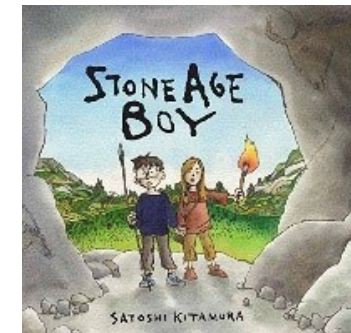
- Counting, comparing and ordering numbers. Counting in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Finding 10 more or less; finding 100 more or less.
- Exploring, estimating and comparing time in seconds, minutes and hours. Calculating time taken.
- Exploring money.



In Writing, we will be learning about:

Writing a short story including: varied punctuation, expanded noun phrases, co-ordinating conjunctions, figurative language and prepositional phrases.

Writing a setting description including: prepositional phrases and synonyms; simple and complex sentences.

- The settlements, civilisations and technology of Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age life.

off by heart.

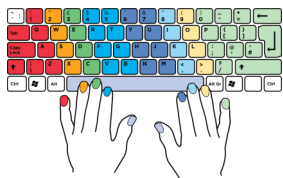
Controlling pitch, rhythm and tempo to
