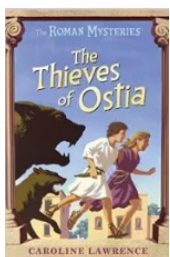
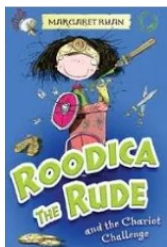

### In Reading, we will be learning about:
