## Autumn 2 Curriculum Overview



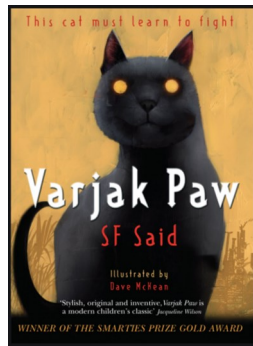
### Dates for the Diary:

### In Reading, we will be learning about:

We will be reading extracts of the book 'Varjak Paw' by SF Said and Horrible Histories by Terry Deary which links to our Project topic based on the Ancient Egyptians. We will use this text, and other texts set to practice reading skills of:

- vocabulary,
- retrieval,
- inference,
- explaining,
- predicting
- summarising.



### In Maths, we will be learning about:

#### Multiplication and Division

We will learn how to multiply 4–digit numbers by 2-digit numbers and we will learn how to use short and long division.

#### Numbers and the Number System

In this unit, we will learn about prime numbers, square numbers, factors and multiples.

#### Checking, approximating and estimating

In this unit, we will be building knowledge and skills to round any number, including decimals and techniques to check our calculations.



### In Writing, we will be learning about:

- 1) How to write an explanation text

We will be writing an explanation for the process of mummification

- 2) How to write a suspense narrative

Within this writing we will learn how to use a range of grammar features and descriptive language to create suspense and tension in our writing.



### Our curriculum project is: Pharaoh's

#### The subject we are studying is history

In this project we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians and who they were. We will research what life was like in ancient Egypt and study primary and secondary sources to understand how we know so much about the ancient Egyptian civilisation.

**In French, we will be learning to:**

Greet and say goodbye to someone; ask  
someone's name and give your own; ask how  
someone is and respond to the  
same question; count numbers 1–  
10; identify musical instruments



**In Music, we will be learning about**

We will be continuing use of Charanga scheme,  
focusing on listening and appraising music.

**In P.E, we will be learning about**

Gymnastics (indoors). Creating sequences and  
synchronised movements.

Football (outdoors). Working on improving de-  
fending/attacking play; develop dribbling, pass-  
ing/receiving a ball and basics of goalkeeping.

**In P.S.H.E / R.H.E , we will be learning about:**

'Celebrating Differences

Within this unit we will learn how people are  
different and why this a positive thing which  
should be celebrated.

**In R.E, we will be learning about Sikhism.**

Children will be taught to understand how and  
why Jewish people celebrate Passover. They will  
learn about the 10 plagues of Egypt and discuss  
a Seder Plate and why it is significant to Jewish  
people.

**In Computing, we will continue our unit**

learning about how to use coding and algo-  
rithms to program a range of codes using Purple  
Mash. We will also begin our  
unit learning about Data.
