## Autumn 1 Curriculum Overview



### Developing speech

**Help them build sentences** – Try to reply to your child using sentences that are a few words longer. For example, if they say, "sock off", respond with "yes, we're taking your sock off".

**Repeating** — get your child to repeat words back to you that they might not know.



### Project

**Our curriculum project is:** *Why do you love me so much?*

**The main subject we will be focusing on is:** *Personal, social and emotional development, personal history*

#### We will be learning about:

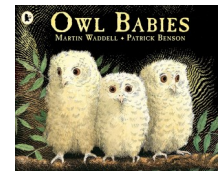
- What we look like

#### Key books:

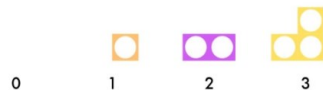
- Guess how much I love you by Sam McBratney

### Maths

**In Maths this half term we will be focusing on numbers 0-3:**

- Number recognition
- Oral counting forwards and backwards
- Identifying numbers, shapes and patterns in the environment
- Place value
- 1:1 correspondence
- Reciting number names



### Literacy

**In Literacy this half term we will be focusing on:**

- Repeating words and phrases from familiar stories
- Language of sequencing—*first, and, then*
- Drawing freely
- Understanding and answering simple questions about who, what and where when discussing stories and rhymes
- Recognise my name
- Pencil grip
