



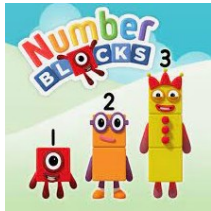

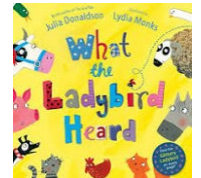


### Literacy

During our literacy sessions we will be learning the rhyme Old MacDonald had a farm, we will be going on listening walks around our school and comparing noises to those on a farm.

The children will be exploring the text What the ladybird heard by Julia Donaldson and creating their very own farm.

Together we will be exploring non-fiction texts to aid our understanding of new vocabulary such as: hatch, peck, nest.



### Maths

In maths we will continue to develop our skills when counting by rote and 1:1 correspondence.

We will be learning new vocabulary to support our positional language, such as: the cow is behind the gate, the pig is next to the trough, the duck is swimming in the pond.

Additionally the children will continue to explore maths through continuous provision including building outside using various shapes and equipment, special awareness and using maths in the creative area.



### Our curriculum project is: Are eggs alive?

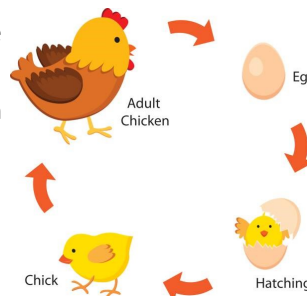
**Our main subject we will be focusing on is: Understanding the World: Science.**
