

The Oaklands Reception Spring 1 Curriculum Overview



Early Reading

This term the children will learn the following graphemes: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oo, ar, er, ow, oi, ear, air, er. They will also cover the tricky words: was, you, they, my, by, all, are, sure, pure. The children will continue to received a weekly reading book in their bookbags for you to share at home and leave a short comment in their reading diaries.



Maths

In maths we will continue to develop our subitising skills, compare numbers to 5, and begin to dig deeper in to the numbers 4 and 5. We will explore how numbers can be made up of two numbers or more through play.

Additionally we will recall our previous learning of capacity and begin to explore and compare mass.

The children will be using a range of representations to support their learning, including the use of a five frame.

The children will receive a five frame to explore at home.

Our curriculum project is: Once upon a time...

Our main subject we will be focusing on is: Expressive arts and design.

We will be learning...

That stories have a beginning, middle and end through role play and retelling Traditional Tales. Together we will be adding music, sound and actions to familiar stories, as well as developing our own narratives based upon the children's own ideas.

The children will be crafting their very own puppets to use in our Puppet Theatres, lets get creative!

We will also be introducing a range of well-known stories and rhymes throughout our Project and together we will be creating an end of Project Performance for our friends.



Writing

This half-term the children will continue to be encourage to apply their phonic knowledge when writing.

We will be exploring the story Jack and The Beanstalk, we will thinking of adjectives to describe each of the characters and creating WANTED posters.

The children will then be introduced to the story Goldilocks and The Three Bears, whereby we will writing instructions to make our own porridge!
