# The Oaklands Reception Spring 2 Curriculum Overview



## Early Reading

This term the children will consolidate their learning of Phase 2 and 3 sounds and review all of their tricky words. The children will continue to receive a weekly reading book in their bookbags for you to share at home and leave a short comment in their reading diaries.



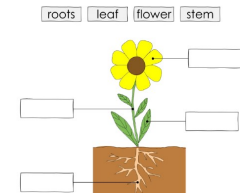
## Writing

This half-term the children will continue to be encouraged to apply their phonic knowledge when writing.

We will be exploring instructions when recalling how to plant a bean to grow our own beanstalks!

We will then be applying adjectives to our writing to create a recount of our trip to Attwell Farm.

The children will also re-visit writing labels when looking closely at parts of a plant.



## Maths

In maths we will continue to develop our subitising skills, compare numbers to 10, and begin to dig deeper in to the numbers 9 and 10.

We will explore how numbers can be made up of two numbers and begin to learn number bonds, for example  $2+3=5$ .

Additionally we will recall our previous learning pattern and progress to making our very own patterns using 3 items.

The children will begin to explore 3D shapes, consider their properties and use them to build in our class construction areas.

## Our curriculum project is: Ready, Steady, Grow!

**Our main subject we will be focusing on is:** Understanding the World: Science.

### We will be learning...

During our Project Ready, Steady Grow! The children will be exploring the growth of both plants and vegetables. We will be looking closely at parts of a plant as well as planting seeds to observe changes over time.

We will explore our new gardening area, as well as visit Attwell Farm!

We will grow our own cress and vegetables to make sandwiches, and taste our home grown food, yummy!
