


## **Dates for the Diary**

## In Reading, we will be learning about:

We will be reading extracts of the book 'Clockwork' by Philip Pullman and 'Counting on Katherine' by Helaine Becker which links to our Project topic based on the solar system. We will use this text, and other texts set to practice the reading skills of vocabulary, retrieval, inference, explaining, predicting and summarising.



In Maths, we will be learning about:

 Continuing approximating and estimating using rounding to find approximate answers t questions and checking our answers.

 Exploring fractions, decimals and percentages – using fractions with all four operations. Finding mixed numbers and improper fractions.

 Measuring space (Converting units of measure) – In this unit we will be calculating perimeter, area and volume.

## The subject we are studying is: Science

Our project will be focusing on the solar system including the moon, planets and significant individuals. We will be learning the names of the planets, where they are located in our solar system and the movement of plants throughout the solar system.

In Writing, we will be learning about:



1) How to write a newspaper article

We will be working alongside The Guardian newspaper to create our own news reports. This will include a workshop to developing our own writing skills and even meeting a real-life journalist for a Q&A session. We will also learn about bias, trustworthy sources, how to spot fake news and the importance of being impartial and fair

2) How to write an effective setting description

Within this writing we will learn how to use expanded noun phrases, conjunctions and figurative language.
