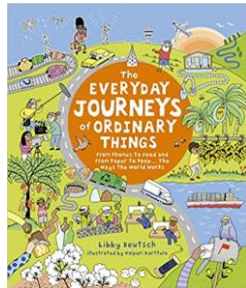

In Reading, we will be learning about:

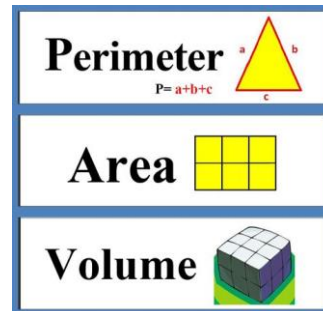


We will be reading extracts of the book 'Oranges in no man's land' by Elizabeth Laird and 'The everyday journey of Ordinary Things' by Libby Deutsch and Stella Gurney. We will use these text, and other texts to practice the reading skills of vocabulary, retrieval, inference, explaining, predicting and summarising.

In Maths, we will be learning about:

1) Measuring space (Converting units of measure) – In this unit we will be calculating perimeter, area and volume

2) Exploring time
Converting units of time and interpreting data from timetables.

We will identify different types of settlements and land use. We will discover where our power comes from consider the use of renewable and non-renewable energy. We will also research where our food comes from and learn about fair trade, food distribution and global food shortages.

In Writing, we will be learning about:

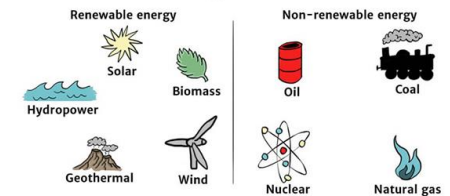
1) How to write a persuasive letter

Within this writing we will learn how to use adverbials of time, place and manner, apostrophes for contraction, past progressive tense, past perfect tense, present perfect tense and parentheses within our writing.

In Art, we will be learning about:

We will be learning about observational drawings, mono-prints, what an architect does and then designing a monument



In French, we will be learning about:
