In Reading, we will be learning about:

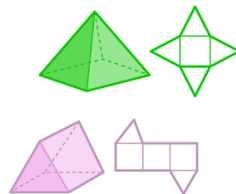
We will be practicing a variety of questions to start to prepare us for our SATs. We will look at a variety of texts to ensure that we have a broad range of reading opportunities.

We will also be reading for pleasure in class and hope that you and your child will continue with this at home.

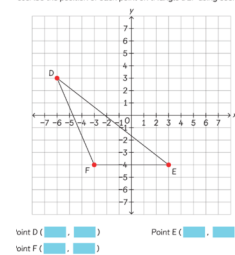


In Maths, we will be learning about:

This half term, we will be learning about movement (co-ordinates, translation and reflection using grids); measurements and conversion between units; recognising different types of angles; visualising and constructing shapes, including 3D nets and shapes; checking, approximating and estimating (rounding numbers including decimal numbers).

In Writing, we will be learning about:



In this half term, we will be firstly be writing to entertain, by writing a narrative based on the Music Video for

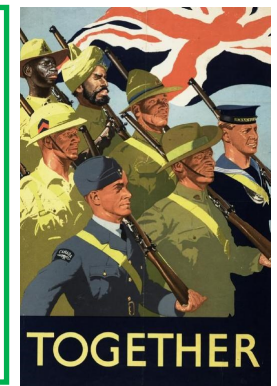
Titanium. The video shows a boy who has powers, and tells the story of how these powers become out of control and how he deals with this.

Then, we will write an informal letter based on the video of The Germans in the Woods. This is a real-life account of an American soldier's experience in the war.

Our curriculum project is: A Child's War

Our main subject we will be focusing on is: History

In this project, we will be learning about the Second World War and the Holocaust. We will begin by learning about the rise of the Nazi party and their beliefs, before moving onto the Holocaust itself. From there we will learn about the Kindertransport, propaganda, the Blitz in Birmingham and the different historical leaders that were involved in the war.



In Art, we will be learning about:

Following our Art Days last half term, our next unit focuses on understanding and exploring meanings behind paintings, and developing personal interpretations and abstract art pieces based on selected artists.

In French, we will be learning about:

During our next unit of French, we will use spoken French to greet people and say our name, age and how we are, ask and say how many brothers and sisters we have, say what someone else has and hasn't got and say what someone is like.



In Music, we will be learning about

This half term, we are very lucky as we will be continuing to use the xylophones in school. We will be using them to help us learning how to play a variety of Jazz music.



In P.E, we will be learning about:

In Computing, we will be learning about:

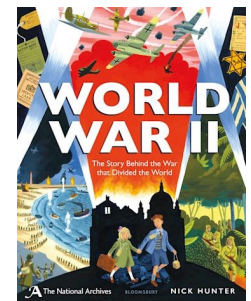
In computing, we will be working with our computing specialists to learn about 3D photography.
